Commission published report ^{73 recommendations}
reviewed previous reports ^{to provoke} desired to be practical
- hope to allow rather than force activity
- changes in municipalities' incentives program grants
- permanent incentives for consolidation in law ²⁰⁰⁷ ²⁰⁰⁸
- aid bonuses for consolidating highway work

Many changes can take place w/o statutory change

Local governments may need technical assistance ^{regulations}

complexity of laws that govern them

- Should negative incentives be used? Not recommended yet.
- Schools are eligible for incentives as are school/municipal
partnerships

- Does Commission have recommendations for infrastructure remediation?

There are NYS + federal funding streams in these areas. Look at need
^{possibly} but do not always require coordination. Some progress on
sewer + water systems
